As Barau, Kano State Government Compete in Offering Scholarships, Can Barau Unseat Kwankwasiyya in 2027?

Senator Barau I. Jibrin, the Deputy Senate President, has been in the headlines since assuming office, proposing initiatives and policies that will win over his senatorial area, Kano North and the state at large. Despite the Kwankwasiyya Tsunami that swept the 2023 polls in Kano, Senator Barau Jibrin scaled through and won his election. Can this be attributed to past projects he completed for his constituency??

keen political observers understand that after emerging as the Deputy Senate President, Senator Barau Jibrin has come up with another strategy which was employed by the Kwankwasiyya political movement when it clinched power in the 2011 general elections in Kano which is offering foreign scholarships to the sons and daughters of the less privileged in the state.

Below is the breakdown of the recent scholarships offered by Senator Barau Jibrin to Kano indigenes as released by his Special Adviser on Media and Publicity, Ismail Mudaahir.

"One week after sponsoring 70 students for postgraduate scholarships abroad, the Deputy President of the Senate, Senator Barau I. Jibrin, is set to offer scholarships to 300 students to pursue Master's degrees in Nigerian universities." the statement reads

"Through the Barau I. Jibrin Foundation (BIJF), 70 students selected from across the three senatorial districts of Kano State departed the country via Malam Aminu Kano International Airport (MAKIA) for India on December 29th, 2024."

In addition, the Deputy President of the Senate, who is also the First Deputy Speaker of the ECOWAS Parliament, announced that 300 students will benefit from his domestic postgraduate scholarship program this year.

To this effect, the foundation opened applications for "postgraduate domestic scholarships for the 2025/2026 academic session."

"The foundation, dedicated to fostering academic excellence and providing educational opportunities to deserving Kano State graduates, aims to support 300 outstanding graduates from recognized universities in pursuing their postgraduate studies at selected universities across the country".

Secretary of the Postgraduate Scholarship Committee of the BIJF, Maikudi Lawan, PhD, said the program offers a unique opportunity for academic growth, research, and human capital development in various fields of science and technology, which will empower the country's next generation.

He said the programs include: M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence, M.Sc. Robotics Technology, M.Sc. Cyber Security, M.Sc. Data Science, M.Sc. Information Technology, M.Sc. Software Development, M.Sc. Mineral Exploration, M.Sc. Hydrogeology & Environmental Geology, M.Sc. Oil and Gas Operations, M.Sc. Applied Geophysics, M.Sc. Metallurgical and Material Engineering, M.Sc. Climate Change Management, M.Eng. Mechatronic and M.Eng. Intelligence System.

He added that six universities, Bayero University Kano, Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, University of Ibadan, University of Lagos, Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife, and University of Nigeria Nsukka, have been selected for the program.

Every political observer in Kano can attest to the success of Kwankwasiyya movement's politics of offering scholarships to the sons and daughters of the less privileged. For example, when the NNPP national leader, Engineer Rabiu Musa Kwankwaso, bounced back as Governor for the second term in 2011, he came up with foreign scholarships for Kano indigenes who had a minimum of second class upper degrees. when such laudable project was announced many people then didn't believe it was going to happen.

The Kwankwasiyya Government sequentially sponsored 501, 502, and 503 set of students on foreign scholarships sent abroad on different batches to study in different fields. This set of people sponsored by Engineer Rabiu Musa Kwankwaso's administration traversed many parts of the world, including India, Cyprus, Egypt, Turkey, Jordan, and other parts of the world.

By the time Governor Kwankwaso finished his second term in 2015, most of the students sponsored had already returned from their studies. Many analysts believed that this life changing opportunities offered by his administration was one of the reasons for the unconditional loyalty of many of the beneficiaries and their families to the the Kwankwasiyya movement.

This among other things was one of the reasons that gave Dr. Abdullahi Umar Ganduje an easy ride leading him to win the 2015 governorship election with a landslide. however, the relationship between Dr. Abdullahi Umar Ganduje and his former boss and political ally deteriorated over time and currently do not see eye to eye due to political differences .

In 2019, the Kwankwasiyya Governorship candidate, Engineer Abba Kabir Yusuf, won the Governorship election in the first round by defeating incumbent Dr. Ganduje, whom they accused of abandoning their programs in which he was the grand Deputy commander of the Kwankwasiyya movement in 2015. it is becoming apparent that Engr. Abba Kabir Yusuf who is the current governor of the state will continue on the legacies laid by the leader of the movement including the sponsoring of students on foreign scholarships.

A lot of people are of the opinion that the current strategy employed by Senator Barau I. Jibrin in offering scholarships to the indigenes of Kano, including the less privileged, is a sign that the Deputy Senate President is eyeing the Kano Governorship seat in the 2027 general elections. Will this be a plot to dislodge the Kwankwasiyya Government under the NNPP led by Governor Abba Kabir Yusuf in the coming elections?

Rep Abubakar Kabir Abubakar Donates Over 9 Million Naira (9,640,000) to Bichi Indigent Science and Technical Boarding School Students as They Resume to School?

BOn Saturday, the Kabir Abubakar Bichi Foundation, under the chairmanship of Dr. Habibu Usman Abdu, inaugurated the support of a 20 thousand Naira stipend each to students who are indigenes of Bichi. The event was held at FCE T Bichi.

t's a tradition maintained by Rep Abubakar Kabir Abubakar to support indigent students from Bichi when they return to boarding school during every term and after vacation.

In his remarks during the occasion, Rep Abubakar Kabir Abubakar urged the students to dedicate themselves to their studies and pledged to continue helping them.

Abubakar Kabir Abubakar said very soon he will renovate 8 secondary schools in his constituency and pledged to sponsor indigenes of the area, mostly women, to Egypt and Saudi Arabia for their tertiary education.

"Our aim is to ensure we get more engineers and doctors, and the renovation of the schools is to make sure students and pupils are not sitting on the floor. We don't want to see any roof wiped out from classes, and the hostels renovated because the dignity of students is to make sure they sleep comfortably," said Rep Bichi.

Rep Bichi said the federal government has also allocated over 1.5 billion for the renovation of Dawakin Tofa Science College and GSS Bichi will also be renovated. He noted that Dan Cin Cin Secondary School is also included.

Rep Bichi added that Hagagawa Primary School will be reconstructed in such a way that it will compete with all the private schools where sons of politicians are attending. He noted that six more primary schools will also be renovated, including Chiranchi and Sabonlayi. "We don't want to play politics with education; that is why we are inviting all and sundry to come and help us in uplifting education in the state," he said.

According to him, apart from 106 teachers manning schools in the area, they have employed 200 more teachers in Bichi, and their screening will soon start. "We are doing this because we have a scarcity of teachers," he added.

He also thanked members of the committee for the disbursement of scholarships and their dedication to education. The conglomeration of students, which included both male and female, thanked Rep Abubakar Kabir Abubakar for the gesture.

In a statement, Alh Auwal said, "All gratitude to Almighty Allah for sparing our lives in good health to witness this auspicious anniversary on your birthday."


He praised the governor's achievements in education, health, and infrastructure, saying they reflect his passion and commitment to developing Kano State.

An Assistant Commissioner of Police in Kano, ACP Daniel Amah, has converted to Islam



Atiku Abubakar Condemns APC's Inflammatory Remarks Against Peter Obi, Warns of Authoritarian Shift

In a scathing critique, 2023 PDP Presidential candidate Atiku Abubakar has condemned the inflammatory remarks issued by the Publicity Secretary of the All Progressives Congress (APC), Felix Morka, directed at Peter Obi, the presidential candidate of the Labour Party in the last general election. Abubakar described these remarks as a disturbing emblem of the current administration's unsettling strategy in addressing opposition figures. "This threat against Obi, coupled with the prolonged detention of Mahdi Shehu, a prominent voice of dissent, signals a worrisome shift towards an authoritarian governance model, where the rights of opposition voices are being suffocated," Abubakar stated.

Abubakar expressed alarm over the choice of words used by the APC's spokesperson, particularly the ominous suggestion that Obi has "crossed the line." He noted, "Such language, rooted in hostility, has no place in a free society where civil discourse and engagement should reign supreme. A true democracy thrives on the healthy exchange of ideas, where the criticisms and contributions of opposition leaders, like Peter Obi, are seen as vital for the betterment of governance and the promotion of public accountability."

Highlighting the duty of a democratic government to listen to its critics, Abubakar emphasized, "It is not merely the right, but the solemn duty of a democratic government to listen attentively to the voices of its critics, to engage in meaningful dialogue, and to allow space for the articulation of alternative viewpoints. Instead, we are faced with a chilling threat that suggests Obi must 'be ready for whatever comes his way.' What, exactly, does Mr. Morka imply by this? It is imperative that the ruling party provides clarity on this disturbing insinuation."

Abubakar also criticized the crude and disparaging manner in which the APC spokesperson framed Peter Obi's calls for constructive engagement, likening them to a lawless Wild West scenario. "Such reckless and derogatory expressions cannot be tolerated, and it is incumbent upon the APC to issue a formal apology to Obi and the Nigerian people for such disgraceful language," he asserted

Addressing the case of Mallam Shehu, who remains in detention without any clear explanation, Abubakar added, "The case of Mallam Shehu, languishing in detention without any clear explanation for his continued imprisonment, adds to the growing concern about the erosion of freedoms in Nigeria. If there is anyone who has truly 'crossed the line,' it is the Tinubu administration, whose continuous vilification of opposition figures as mere irritants to be crushed is a dangerous precedent."

Abubakar called for immediate intervention from all men and women of goodwill, urging the Tinubu government to recalibrate its approach to dealing with dissent and opposition. "The time has come to put an end to this stifling of voices that are crucial to the health of any functioning democracy," he concluded.

Gov. Bala Mohammed Accused of Playing Irresponsible Politics by Tinubu Administration

The President Bola Tinubu administration has accused Governor Bala Mohammed of Bauchi State of playing irresponsible politics, urging him to focus on governance and addressing the issues facing his state. This statement was made by Sunday Dare, Special Adviser to the President on Media and Public Communication, in a press release dated January 10, 2025.

According to Dare, the Tinubu administration is laser-focused on development and improving the overall well-being of Nigerians. "The focus of this government is on how to build stronger collaborations with sub-nationals and other critical stakeholders on matters that affect the lives of Nigerians," he stated.

Dare emphasized that President Tinubu won an election and secured a national mandate from Nigerians, which he will not surrender to satisfy the palate of pseudo-activists and later-day crusaders. "President Tinubu is a listening leader and also a leader that strongly believes in the institutions of state," Dare added.

Addressing the Tax Reform Bills, Dare noted that the President was clear that anyone and groups that feel strongly about the matter now before the National Assembly should take advantage of the legislative process. "Attempts to stampede or abort this process must be regarded as undemocratic and self-serving," he asserted.

"How well are the people of his state faring under his leadership? How well has he as Governor used the increased resources at his disposal to improve the quality of life of his people?" Dare asked. "Constant blustering and playing irresponsible politics will not relieve him of his duty to the people of Bauchi State, whom his leadership has impoverished," Dare stated. He urged Governor Bala to face governance and stop using President Tinubu to burnish his vanishing image.

Dare highlighted President Tinubu's focus on revamping the economy and working to turn the economic fortunes of the country around. "He has a four-year mandate to deliver on his promises. Dare further reiterated that Governor Bala is playing irresponsible politics and should instead occupy himself with dealing with the many problems of his state. "Ambition is made of sterner stuff," he remarked.

The Kano State Government has expressed profound satisfaction with the recent judgment delivered by the Court of Appeal, Abuja Division, regarding the Emirate Council matter involving His Highness Khalifa Muhammadu Sanusi II and other parties. This was announced during a press conference jointly addressed by the Hon. Attorney General/Commissioner for Justice, Hon. Commissioner for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs, and Hon. Commissioner for Information, Kano State, on Saturday, January 11, 2025, at the NUJ Press Centre, Kano.

"On behalf of the Kano State Government, we express our profound satisfaction with the Judgment delivered by the Court of Appeal, Abuja Division, regarding the Emirate Council matter involving His Highness Khalifa Muhammadu Sanusi II and other parties," stated the Hon. Attorney General/Commissioner for Justice.

The verdict overturns earlier decisions by the Federal High Court and validates the government's lawful actions regarding chieftaincy appointments and reforms in the state's traditional institutions. "This ruling reaffirms the government's commitment to justice, fairness, and adherence to due process in our efforts to modernize traditional structures while preserving the cultural heritage of Kano State," added the Hon. Commissioner for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs.
